

CapCut – easy to use, AI tools, mobile and desktop versions.

Adobe Premiere Pro – industry standard, complex features.

Final Cut Pro – popular among Mac users.

DaVinci Resolve – free version with advanced features.

Canva – simple design tool for social media content.

Adobe Photoshop – professional image editing.

GIMP – free alternative to Photoshop.

Audacity – free sound editing software.

Adobe Audition – professional audio design tool.

- **Media Library**: Importing and managing assets.









Editing Features

- **Transitions & Effects**: Enhancing video aesthetics.
- Text & Titles: Adding subtitles and captions.
- **Color Grading**: Adjusting colors for better visuals.
- Al Features: Automated subtitle generation, background removal.
